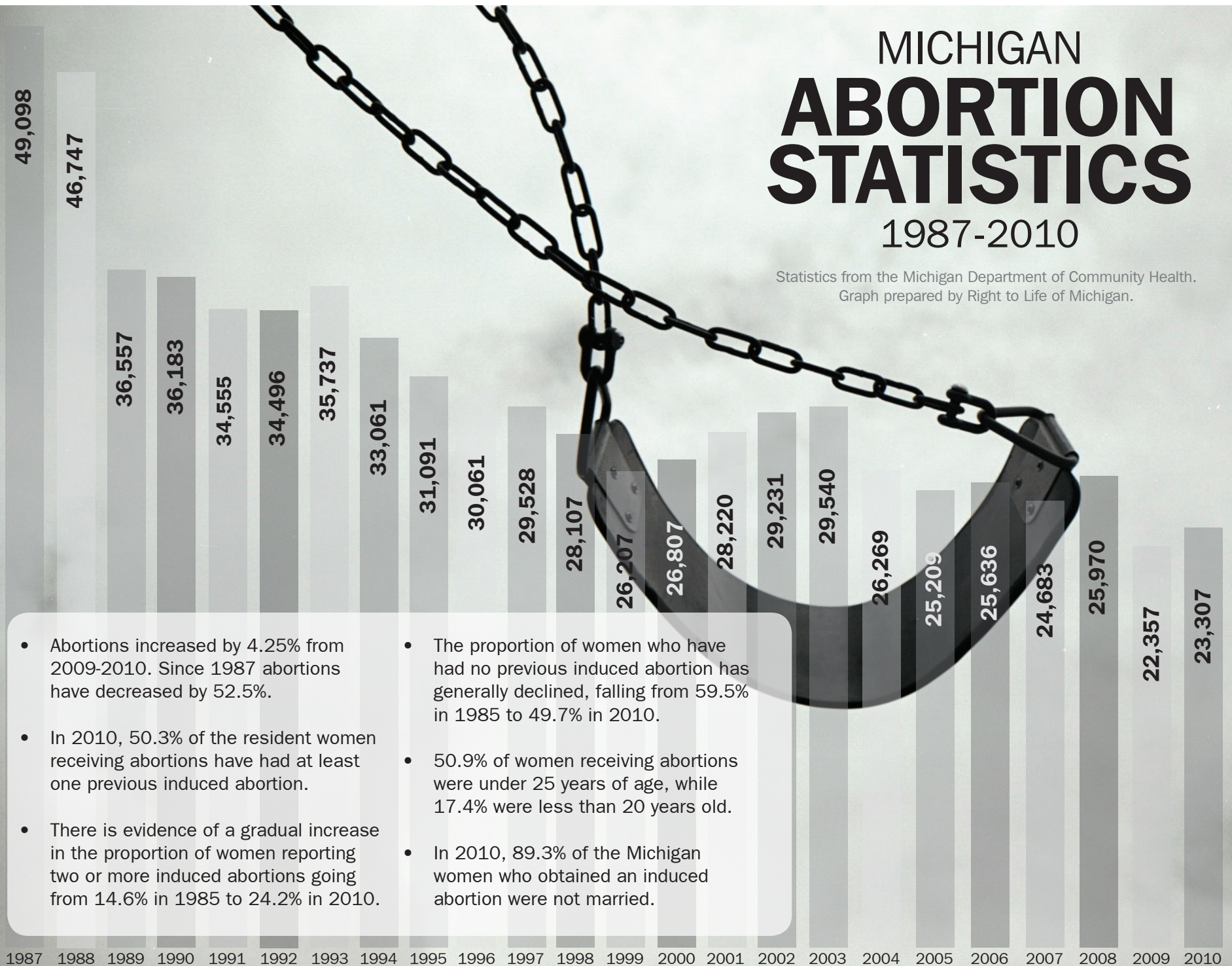


MICHIGAN ABORTION STATISTICS

1987-2010

- Abortions increased by 4.25% from 2009-2010. Since 1987 abortions have decreased by 52.5%.
- In 2010, 50.3% of the resident women receiving abortions have had at least one previous induced abortion.
- There is evidence of a gradual increase in the proportion of women reporting two or more induced abortions going from 14.6% in 1985 to 24.2% in 2010.
- The proportion of women who have had no previous induced abortion has generally declined, falling from 59.5% in 1985 to 49.7% in 2010.
- 50.9% of women receiving abortions were under 25 years of age, while 17.4% were less than 20 years old.
- In 2010, 89.3% of the Michigan women who obtained an induced abortion were not married.
